Pet waste left on the street or lawn does not just go away or fertilize the grass. The bacteria in pet waste is often washed down storm drains and into ditches, stream, lakes and inlets, and can travel for miles in the water.

So what can you do? Simple.

Whether you are in your yard or on a walk, dispose of your pet's waste promptly in the trash to prevent it from entering storm drains and roadside ditches. Simply bring plastic bags with you when you walk your pet. Use a bag to pick up the pet waste, tie closed and place in trash.
